



Palestinian Pulse Report for September 2024

A public opinion survey conducted in West Bank & Gaza Strip by the [Palestinian Center for Policy and Survey Research \(PSR\)](#) for the Palestinian Peace Coalition/ Two-State-Coalition finds that October 7th and the current war have been harmful to the Palestinian interests, with the majority calling for an end of the war, a Palestinian state based on 1967 borders, and return to good neighborly relations. **51% of Palestinians prefer the two-state solution over any other option.** Below are the detailed results of the poll, which was conducted during Sept. 3-7, 2024. The sample size of this survey was 1200 people, of whom 790 were interviewed face-to-face in the West Bank (in 79 residential locations) and 410 in the Gaza Strip (in 41 locations). The margin of error stands at +/-3.5%.

Q 1: Do you support or oppose the establishment of an independent Palestinian state on the territories occupied in 1967?

- Overall Support: 59%
 - West Bank: 60%
 - Gaza Strip: 59%
- Opposition: 37%
 - West Bank: 36%
 - Gaza Strip: 39%
- Don't Know/No Answer (DK/NA): 3%
 - West Bank: 4%
 - Gaza Strip: 1%

Q2: Do you support ending the war with a prisoner swap deal, return of Palestinian workers to Israel and having good-neighborly relations between the Palestinians and Israelis?

- Yes: 70%
 - West Bank: 73%
 - Gaza Strip: 65%
- No: 29%
 - West Bank: 26%
 - Gaza Strip: 35%
- Don't Know/No Answer (DK/NA): 1%
 - West Bank: 1%
 - Gaza Strip: 0%

Q3: In your view, has October 7 and subsequent war on Gaza harmed the future of the Palestinian people or benefited it?

- Harmed It: 63%
 - West Bank: 58%
 - Gaza Strip: 71%
- Benefited It: 33%



- West Bank: 37%
- Gaza Strip: 26%
- Don't Know/No Answer (DK/NA): 4%
 - West Bank: 5%
 - Gaza Strip: 3%

Q4: In light of the current war, what solution do you prefer to solve the Palestinian-Israeli conflict?

- Two-State Solution According to 1967 Borders: 51%
 - West Bank: 49%
 - Gaza Strip: 54%
- Two States with Confederation: 19%
 - West Bank: 14%
 - Gaza Strip: 27%
- One State with Equal Rights for Jews and Palestinians: 10%
 - West Bank: 11%
 - Gaza Strip: 9%
- Don't Know/No Answer (DK/NA): 21%
 - West Bank: 27%
 - Gaza Strip: 11%
